BYLAW NO. 06/2021 CASH COLLECTIONS BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF ISLAND VIEW, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO BE KNOWN AS THE BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS

The Council of the Resort Village of Island View in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Designated officer" shall mean
 - i) the person appointed as the Administrator of the municipality; or
 - ii) the person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
 - b) "Council" means the Council of the Resort Village of Island View;
 - c) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Island View.
- The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Municipality, in a financial institution designated by Council, all moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$5,000.
- 3. At the discretion of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but in any case, not less than once a month nor more than once each day.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final date of passing by Council.
