BYLAW 5-2001

(adapted from Section 135, The Urban Municipality Act, 1984)

A BYLAW TO REGULATE DOGSRUNNING AT LARGE

THE COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF ISLAND VIEW IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "Dog" shall mean either male or female canine;
 - (b) "administrator" shall mean the clerk or administrator of the Resort Village of Island View.
 - (c) "Resort" shall mean the Resort Village of Island View.
 - (d) "running at large" shall mean when the dog is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor, or harbourer of the said dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is nor under control by being:
 - (i) in the direct and continuous charge of a person competent of control it; or
 - (ii) securely confined within an enclosure or
 - (iii) securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.
- 2. No dog shall run at large in the Resort.
- Dogs shall be leashed when on public lands.
- 4. The administrator will be advised of any infractions of this bylaw.
- 5. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of sections 1,2 or 3 of this bylaw, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fixed penalty:
 - (a) The administrator will issue a letter of warning to the dog owner, for the first offence.
 - (b) For second offence of this bylaw the owner will be charged a fine of not less than \$25.00.
 - (c) For a third and every subsequent offence of this bylaw the owner will be charged a fine of not less \$75.00, for each offence.
 - (d) The administrator will advise the R.C.M.P. of any infractions of this bylaw
