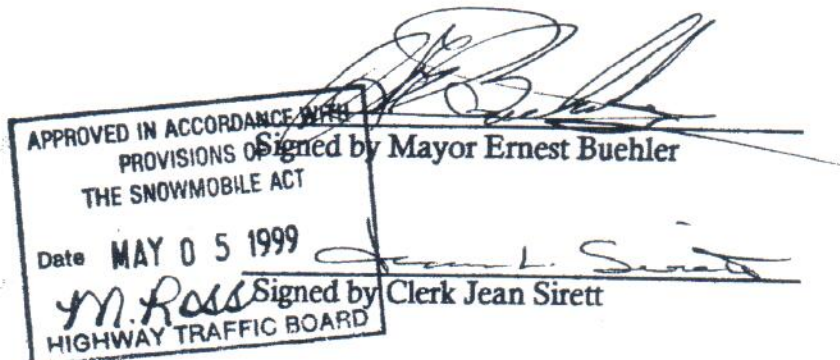

BYLAW NO. 2/99
Resort Village of Island View

**TO AMEND BYLAW # 07/94 PERMITTING AND REGULATING THE
OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES**

The Council of the Resort Village of Island View in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) In this bylaw, including this section:
 - a) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act
 - b) "snowmobile" means a vehicle as defined in The Snowmobile Act
- 2) That Bylaw number 07/94 is amended by deleting clause 1, namely "Under the provisions of The Snowmobile Act, it shall be lawful to operate a licensed snowmobile between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 midnight on any road within the limits of the Resort Village", and by substituting the following:
 - a) No person shall operate a snowmobile on any road/highway within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Island View;
 - b) It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile only on the untravelled portion of the road allowances within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Island View.
- 3) A person who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not more than \$100.00 for the first offence and not more than \$200.00 for each subsequent offence.
- 4) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the approval of the Highway Traffic Board.
